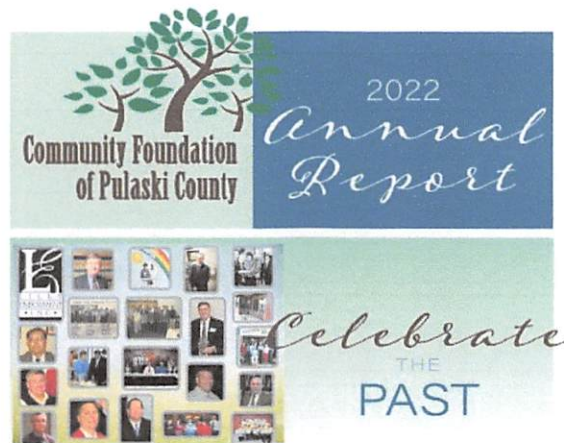


Sneak Peek: New Office
